A LOCAL AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF DOLGEVILLE, NEW YORK

I. Findings.

The Board of Trustees finds that Article II, Section 10-20, of the Code of Ordinances regarding certain speed limits should be amended in order to address concerns which have arisen in

particular areas of the Village.

Section 10-20 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to Section 10-20. II. fully read as follows until further amended by local law:

No person shall operate a motor vehicle or motorcycle on South (a) Established. Helmer Avenue in the vicinity of the playgrounds between Baker Street and Cramer Lane, and on East Spofford Avenue between Howard Street and Ransom Street, in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour. This section shall not apply to ambulance, fire vehicles or

police vehicles when on emergency trips.

No person shall operate a motor vehicle of motorcycle on Slawson (b) Slawson Street. Street from the west side of South Helmer Avenue to the easterly boundary line of the Dolgeville Central School district in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour. This section shall not apply to ambulances, fire vehicles or police vehicles when on emergency

trip.

No person shall operate a motor vehicle or motorcycle on Beaver (c) Beaver Street. Street from the west side of South Helmer Avenue to the end of Beaver Street in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour. This section shall not apply to ambulances, fire vehicles or police vehicles

when on emergency trip.

No person shall operate a motor vehicle o motorcycle on Cline (d) Cline Street. Street from the south side of Slawson Street to the north side of Beaver Street in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour. This section shall not apply to ambulances, fire vehicles or police vehicles

when on emergency trip.

Adequate signs shall be erected in the vicinity of all Village (e) Signs. Playgrounds warning motorists of the approach thereto and the speed limits in the vicinity of said playgrounds, in addition to the speed limits on all streets identified herein.
