PUBLIC BODY- Any entity for which a quorum is required in order to conduct public business and which consists of two or more members performing a governmental function for the state or for an agency or department thereof, or for a public corporation as defined in section 66 of the General Construction Law or committee or subcommittee or other similar body consisting of members of such public body, or an entity created or appointed to perform a necessary function in the decision making process for which a quorum is required to conduct public business and which consists of two or more members. A necessary function in the decision making process shall not include the provision of recommendations or guidance which is purely advisory and which does not require further action by the state or agency or department thereof or public corporation as defined in section 66 of the General Construction Law.

Section 2. Attendance of meetings via videoconference for extraordinary circumstances authorized.

- A. The Village Board authorizes its members and members of any other public body of the village who experience extraordinary circumstances to participate in meetings using videoconferencing technology in a manner consistent with section 103-a of the Public Officers Law.
- B. The Village Board shall, by resolution, create written procedures further governing its use of videoconferencing by its members in compliance with section 103-a of the Public Officers Law.

Section 3. Separability.

The provisions of this local law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words or parts of this local law or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this local law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein and if such person or circumstance to which the local law or part thereof is held inapplicable had been specifically exempt therefrom.

Section 4. Repealer.

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this local law are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon the filing with the New York State secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

The following resolution offered by Trustee Jaquay sec. Trustee Madore. Ayes all.

By passing Chapter 56 of the Laws of 2022, the New York State legislature amended section 103 of the Public Officers Law to add section 103-a. Section 103-a of the Public Officers Law permits the village to authorize members of its public bodies to attend meetings by videoconference under extraordinary circumstances.

Section 103-a(2)(a) of the Public Officers Law requires that the Village Board adopt a local law, following a public hearing, authorizing the limited use of videoconferencing under extraordinary circumstances.

Section 1. Definitions

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meaning indicated below:

EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES-For the purposes of this article, "extraordinary circumstances" means, disability, illness, caregiving responsibilities, inclement weather, travel or a significant or any other significant or unexpected factor or event which prevents a member of a public body from attending a meeting of the public body in person.

PUBLIC BODY – Any entity for which a quorum is required in order to conduct public business and which consists of two or more members performing a governmental function for the state or for any agency or department thereof, or for a public corporation as defined in section 66 of the General Construction Law or committee or other similar body consisting members of such public body, or an entity created or appointed to perform a necessary function in the decision making process for which a quorum is required to conduct public business and which consists of two or more members. A necessary function in the decision making process shall not include the provision of recommendations or guidance which is purely advisory and which does not require further action by the state or agency or department thereof or public

corporation as defined in section 66 of the General Construction Law.

Section 2. Attendance of meetings via videoconference for extraordinary circumstances authorized.

- A. The Village Board authorized its members and members of any other public body of the village who experience extraordinary circumstances to participate in meetings using videoconferencing technology in a manner consistent with section 103-a of the Public Officers Law.
- B. The Village Board shall, by resolution, create written procedures further governing its use of videoconferencing by its members in compliance with section 103-a of the Public Officers Law.

Section 3. Separability.

The provisions of this local law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, work or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsection, words or parts of this local law or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this local law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, work or part had not been included therein and if such person or circumstance to which the local law or part thereof is held inapplicable had been specifically exempt therefrom.

Section 4. Repealer.

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this local law are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon the filing with the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
