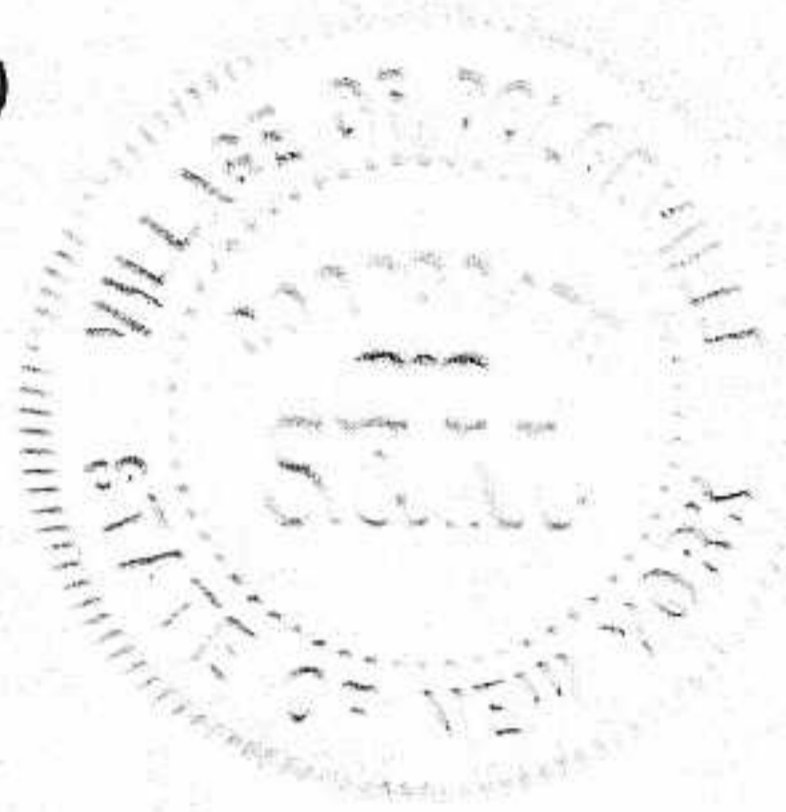

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2021

A local law adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law §131 opting out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Village of Dolgeville.

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to opt the Village of Dolgeville out of hosting retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law §131, which expressly authorizes cities and villages to opt-out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments to locate and operate within their boundaries.

Section 3. Local Cannabis Retail Dispensary and/or On-site Consumption Opt-Out.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Dolgeville, County of Herkimer and Fulton, hereby opts out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be

confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly, involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Pursuant to Cannabis Law §131, this local law is subject to a permissive referendum and thus may not be file with the Secretary of State until the applicable time period has elapsed to file a petition or a referendum has been conducted approving this local law.
