Current Work:

- Installed new street signs on east side of village and south end
- Assisted with reservoir cleaning
- Move excess stone from paving staging area to hilltop
- Restripe crosswalks for new school year
- Replaced Hydrant #89 on Stewart St
- Repaired Hydrant #21 on N Main St
- Attempted repair on Hydrant #74 on Ransom St
 - Barrel cracked now scheduled for replacement this week
- Hydrant #57 on VanBuren St scheduled for replacement
 - Awaiting rental vacuum excavator equipment
 - This is needed due to the gas main being close to the hydrant and the subcontracted locator for National Grid is not confident in the location due to the proximity of water lines to gas lines
- As always weekly and monthly checks have been made of the sewer system "trouble" areas
- A letter was submitted to Dolgeville FAFA regarding the Villages' in-kind contribution to playground renovations
- Loader replacement should still be considered
