A local law Regulating The Parking of Vehicles in Public Parking Lots.

Section 1. Legislative Intent.

It is the intent of the Village of Dolgeville to regulate the parking of motor vehicles in the public parking lots of said Village, pursuant to the authority contained in the Village Law and the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. Definitions.

For the purposes of this local law, the following terms shall have the meanings ascribed to them. All other words shall have the meaning normally ascribed to them in regular usage.

- a. "Motor vehicle" shall mean a vehicle as defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law.
- b. "Public parking lot" shall mean any off-street parking facility owned, operated or maintained by the Village of Dolgeville.
- c. "Parking spaces" shall mean those areas of a public parking lot defined for the parking of motor vehicles by paint strips or other markings.
- d. "Village" shall mean the incorporated Village of Dolgeville.

Section 3. Restrictions and Prohibitions.

The following restrictions and prohibitions shall be in full force and effect for all public parking lots within the Village:

- a. Parking restricted. No person shall park or leave standing any motor vehicle in a public parking lot unless said motor vehicle is within the confines of a parking space.
- b. Time limitation. No person shall park or leave standing any motor vehicle in a public parking lot for a continuous period of time in excess of two (2) hours.

c. Over-night parking prohibited. No motor vehicle shall be parked or left standing in any public parking lot within the Village between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M.

Section 4. Penalties.

Each violation of this local law shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00). A violation of this local law shall constitute a traffic infraction within the meaning of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

Section 5. Validity.

Should any provision of this law be judicially determined to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Repeal of Inconsistent Laws.

Any law, rule, regulation or ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 7. Effective date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
