Re: August 2021 Monthly Report

Current Work:

- Weekly Green Waste Collection  
Most People are following the Green Waste Collection Policy. Within the Month, we will start leaf pick up along with our Green Waste Collection.
- Weekly Checks of Sewers and Water Leaks  
Put out Water Shut Off notices for Rental Units.
- Mowing & Weed eating of Village Parks & Trails as needed.
- Changing Garbage's at Parks Weekly.
- Daily 811 Requests
- Checking Storm drains after Rain events.
- 1 Complaint for Mowing Parks too early in the morning. We are trying to mow parks a little later to avoid conflicts.

## Water/Sewer

- Pad at Water Treatment Plant complete.
- Fire on VanBuren St- Water Shut off and 811 Request complete.
- Plugged Lateral at 38 E. Faville cleared and checked with camera.
- Delivered 8-inch Pipe and positioned for fitting at Water Treatment Plant.
- Checked out low pressure complaint on the Southside of the Village- Unfounded.
- 811 Request completed for Town of Manheim.

## Streets

- We are all done cutting back roadsides and streets. The mower was cleaned and returned to Oppenheim.
- Trimmed Trees on Cline Street that were overhanging edge of Culvert (Both sides of Street).
- Complaints about dead trees on Faville Ave. Rick Barnes removed both tree as they were previously Quoted and Approved.
- Cold Patched Road Cuts on Timmerman St and 112 S. Main St.
- Cold Patched Winton Lane and road cuts on Helmer and Main Patched.
- Catch Basins on Elm St and Lamberson St repaired.
- Emergency Dig at 53 South Main St due to Sinkhole developed at the Sidewalk. The sinkhole is the State's Storm Sewer. We repaired because they had no crew available. We replaced a section of 18-inch Galvanized Pipe and filled the hole.



- Howard St Extension had a soft plug in the line. Advised Homeowner to call a Plumber.
- Faville Ave found Roots in the Lateral. Advised Homeowner to call a Plumber to have line cut to avoid further issues.
- School Crosswalks have been repainted.
- Hanging flowers are all down now.
- Replaced Sewer Cover on Spencer St by the Tracks.
- Installed 2 Manhole Cover risers for Spencer St.
- Filled in the Elm St DI Patch.
- Checked and filled sinkhole and low spot on Ransom St.
- Shared Services with Oppenheim for a total of 6 days in August.

## Garage

- 12-Freightliner was cleaned, waiting on bearings for Salter, 1 4x4 needs to be replaced and new headlight need to be installed. Stenciling has been completed on side of Truck. Salter Bar has been refitted and we are still rust controlling the Wheels.
- Street Sign Inventory done on signs we propose to replace.
- "09" Freightliner sent to Johnstown for Repair of a broken front spring. Found 3 Brakes nonfunctional, 2 due to slack adjuster not functioning and 1 due to a broken brake can. Also, a bad grease seal and rear brakes were done due to the bad seal.
- Leaf Picker- has a bad Baring on the Swivel (need to order), a broken Mount which has been repaired, unit has been Greased and Serviced. It is almost ready for Leaf season.
- Called on Salt. Moved our Quota from 600 to 495 Tons.



- DEC Paperwork for Bulk Fuel Storage Completed and turned into Tammy.
- Garage Toilet Broke off Mount and a new Toilet was purchased and installed.
- We have been painting and doing General Maintenance around the Garage.

## Village Hall

- Pressure washed Porch, Concrete steps, walkways, Pavers and Sign.
- Porch will need a coat of paint
- Measured storm and Entry Door per Request. Starting Quoting- Can discuss.

## Parks

- Waiting for Rick Barnes to cut Trees in Plowe Park.
- Damage was found at Center Park Gray Building. PD notified. Tables were pulled due to Trash and Vandalism and are stored at the Pavilion.
- Removed another Portable Basketball Hoop from Center Park. It is at the Police Station.
