Work: Current

- Weekly Green Waste Collection
We are picking up Christmas Trees as we see them.
- Weekly Checks of Sewers
- Shoveling Village Walkways, Plowing and Salting
- Daily 811 Requests
- Checking Storm drains

Water/Sewer

- We ran a camera on a Stewart St Address and found a blockage within ten feet along with a heavily corroded Pipe. Stopped as to not further plug line. Informed Homeowner they need a Plumber.
- Flushed North Main Street line for 3 Hours.
- Jetted Helmer Ave from Fire House to Baker St- Preventative Maintenance.
- Plugged Sewer Complaint on Stewart St. Sewer bagged, and problem resolved.
- Lowered a Water Shut off at 36 S Helmer per request and 6 Horn St.
- Cleaned Drains in Upper garage and flushed lines.
- Cleaned Drains in Main garage and flushed Lines (Heavy Buildup). Took Debris from drains to Hilltop for disposal.
- Brought back metal waste from Wastewater Treatment
- Refilled Co2 Tanks for Freeze kit

Streets

- Tricot Pond- We believe the Beavers are gone. Damns have been opened and Levels have dropped. We have permission to remove material to get backhoe in and remove lower damn from Tricot.
- Took down Christmas Decorations/Lights. Took photos for Insurance and emailed them. They still have value; I would like to discuss putting them into lots and auctioning them
- Delineators put on Millers Grove Rd.
- Cold Patching throughout the Village, still ongoing.
- New Street signs came in and we are putting them up as time permits.

- Salting Parks, Church, Water Treatment Plant and Plowing of Cemetery.
- Continual Cleaning of Grate on Ransom St due to Beaver debris
- Returned inner Flowerpots to Herkimer.

Garage

- 3500- still needs Radio Installed.
 - Salt ordered as needed
 - "09" Freightliner- Greased Chassis and Dump Body.
 - Training of New Employee on Equipment and Bill B on "12" Freightliner.
 - "12" Freightliner- Changed Cutting Edge and working out bugs with head plow. Ordered single side cutting edge as a spacer plate. Power steering leak due to bad clamp at Power steering reservoir. Issue Resolved. Replaced a pair of quick couplers (Hydraulic Connections) on the head plow unit due to leaking.
 - An Electric heater is placed in the breakroom. The gas-powered unit we have needs replacement.
 - 550- Serviced salter. Cutting edges installed.
 - Snowman- No new Problems to date
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- Monthly Fuel Tank Inspections are done this Month and Fuel logs changed out.
 - Constantly cleaning inside the Garage to improve.

- Purchased a 40x60 tarp. Installed over existing tarp to try to resolve roof leaking.
- When time permitting Greg is getting road time for his Permit.
- Need to discuss Camera system for exterior of Garage Building.
- Backhoe- Fixed a Quick Coupler issue for the jack hammer.
- Met with Jablonski about plowing snow and came to an agreement at Kinney's.
- Would like to Discuss Metal Waste and Oil Waste

Parks

- Rick Barnes has started to cut trees.
- Helterline Park- Took all Plant life out of park. It is prepped and ready for seed in the spring.
- Center Park/ Baker St property- All topsoil is down and graded, ready for seeding in Spring.
- Garbage's on Main Street Parks have been removed. Plastic bags have been over the top of containers to avoid potential mess in the spring.
- Removed barricades from the Greenway trail.

- Plowe Park- All Christmas Ornaments have been removed from the park and sign returned to George Lumber.
- Old Library- Fixed Door handle per request. Built out and fit railing for Library.
