- Sewer complaint on Main St- Cleared debris from Manhole, Jetted sewer main's, Main St from Spofford to Faville- Resolved.

- Picked up used oil at Waste Water
- Plowing at WWTP
- Added fill to Cline St for Storm Project
- Took Bullett to Middleville to confirm function

Streets

Found broken bolts and cracking on wing- Welded crack at front, pulled rear mount back into position, installed new bolt, cut and dressed metal and re-welded rear connection “heel”. Flipped Cutting Edges on head plow and completed rust control along with repaired a broken hinge on the passenger side trip.
