## **Current Work:**

- Weekly Green Waste Collection- Multiple Piles and Containers cannot be picked up by 2 people let alone 1.
   Some people are putting out 150 (plus) pounds that is minus the rain. There may be some complaints, but we need to stand by our Green Waste Policy. It is not physically possible to lift them.
- Weekly checks of Sewers and Water leaks- Current 83 N.
  Main St.

(Sullivan Street has had a buildup)

- Weekly mowing and Weed eating of Village Parks and Trails.
- Changing Garbage's at Parks weekly.
- Daily 811 Requests
- Checking storm drains as rain events come. Storm drain by Gehring Tricot keeps getting blocked with Debris.

### Water/Sewer:

- Removed Snails from Solid Contact Tank at Wastewater Plant.
- Delivered and set 300 to 400' of 6" Pipe at Wastewater Plant for Reservoir. This was unused pipe sitting behind DPW Garage.
- Releveled blacktop at Wastewater due to damage from an 18-Wheeler turning around.
- Cold Patch at Wastewater and was seal coated.
- Received a call from Resident on 7/4 about low water pressure. I found the PSI was 60 and called Neil to check the Water Plant. We were losing 1K plus GPM. Checking through the Village we found a broken pipe at Daniel Green Building and shut off the water.
- We cleaned the Reservoir on July 7<sup>th</sup> and created a new Landing (Path) for next year.

### Streets:

- Cleared Down Tree on Park Ave along with other Streets and Bever Brook.
- Checked Trees on Wolf St per Request. They are already cut except for Stumps about 10' tall and appears to be concrete filled. The request was denied due to the Size, Weight, and possibility of damaging Property.
- Dig Holes were filled at 6 Helmer Ave with Cold Patch
- Cleaned Village Lot across from Village Hall, Removed Trees, Debris and Garbage. We removed 4 Truck Loads.
- Cut back road edges that had tree overgrowth.
- Driveway Complaint on Wolf St. We used ¼ bucket of crusher run to create an Apron 36" Wide by 20 Feet Long.
   We fixed a low Apron down the street with the remainder of crusher run.

- Kinney's was Cold patched for Seal coating.
- Senior Banners were taken down and delivered to School.
- Sealcoating of DPW lot, Village Hall, Lot across from Village Hall and Kinney's complete.
- Striping Complete for Village Hall, the Lot across from Village Hall and Kinney's.

# Garage:

- Set up New Time Clock
- Online PERMA Training Completed
- Called DEC about Fox Kits living under the DPW Garage and Advised PD.
- Picked up 2012 Freightliner on 7/14/2021, it is at DPW Garage if any Board Member would like to come check it out.

### Parks:

- Removed Stump from Center Park along with Garbage littered.
- Picked up Tree Limbs at Little League Park and took a Damage Complaint that was sent to the Board earlier this week.
- Trimmed up Trees at Plowe Park (Complaint from HBE Group)
- Cut off remnants of broken benches (Trip Hazards) at Luther Park.
- Filled Holes and Regraded wet spots on trails.
- A New Base was made and Handicapped Sign Re-installed.

### To Do:

Continue Street Sign Repair and Replacement.

- Waiting to get Confirmation if we own dead trees in Park (Lawyer Question)
- Waiting for Clarification on Sidewalk for "Tree Cutbacks" (Lawyer Question)
- Manheim Rental Mower coming soon to do Road Edges and cut back Streets.
- Hydrant Testing and Service Painting as Time Permits.
- Cold Patching
- Water Leak next week at 112 S. Main St.
- Sidewalk Removal at 16 Cline St
- Ditching
- We will be installing an 8" Line at Water Reservoir using left over 8" Pipe.
