Re: May 2021 Monthly Report

Current work from the middle of April to the middle of May:

- **Roads**
 - Filling in potholes with cold patch as they open up in the village roads.
 - Contacting the NYSDOT about potholes on Main Street / Helmer Avenue and or any other issues on the state road thru the village.
 - Fixing any damage caused by village plow trucks from the winter plowing season. That includes properties and roads.
 - Working on sweeping entire village roads to remove, sand, salt, debri and garbage collected over the winter season.
 - NYSDOT swepted all the state roads in the village limits.
 - County is paving spencer street and parts of west state street in the village limits.
 - Permit for Flags up on Main street
- **Sewer**
 - Normal weekly / monthly checks.
 - Flushed the sewer line the entire length of winton lane. Flushed the sewer line between spofford square and howard street. Flushed east state street / dolge ave ext. sewer. Flushed sewer east faville ave from south main to howard street. Flushed sewer Helmer ave from cramer lane to baker street. Flushed all of Lamberson street. Flushed all of Howard street extension. Flushed Helmer ave from west state street to Kinney's entrance. Flushed manhole at the corner of west spofford ave and south helmer ave.
 - Flushing the downstream siphon manhole once a week.

- **Storm Sewer**
 - Cleaning off catch basin of sticks and garbage after weather events.
 - Checking culverts and drainage areas in the village.
- **Center Park / Pavilion Grant / All Parks**
 - Cleaning up of debris, garbage, and green waste in all village parks.
 - Center Park / Playground picking up garbage that kids are throwing around the playground.
 - Ordering parts for the zipline at the playground which is broken.
 - Turned water on in the gray building next to the playground.
 - Mowing and weed whacking weekly.
 - Farmers Market
 - Violet Festival Permit
- **Signs**
 - Checking Village signs throughout the Village that got damaged during the winter snow events.
 - 15 minute parking south main street.
- **Water**
 - Digging on East Timmerman Street to locate old water valve.
 - Cleaning water valve boxes in village streets.
 - Fixing curb boxes that were damaged during the winter months.
 - 811 mark outs.
 - Fixed Dolge ave water leak.
- **Greenway Trail**
 - Checked trail for any washed-out areas and drainage issues.
- **WTP**
 - Leak detection.
- **WWTP**
 - Helping with spring cleaning.
- **Village Hall**
 - Fixed lawn and picked up garbage.
 - Mowing and weed whacking weekly.
- **Village Codes Officer**
 - 98 North Helmer Ave Building Demolition.
 - Village buildings.
 - North Main street where flooded.

- Furniture and garbage at the curb thru out the village.
- Playground pavilion.
- **Village Engineer**
 - Working on 2021 Paving.
 - Working with FEMA on North Main Street and Fink Creek.
 - Working on the culverts that throughout the Village.
 - Working on figuring out sidewalk on cline street from spencer street to Beaver Street.
- **Old Library**
 - Fixed lawn and picked up garbage.
 - Mowing and weed whacking weekly.
- **Museum**
 - Fixed lawn and picked up garbage.
 - Mowing and weed whacking weekly.
- **Green Waste Pick Up**
 - We have been picking up green waste on Mondays for the entire village.
 - Picking up tree branches that are in the road that are knocked down during storm events.
 - Residents are and can call for trucks for green waste removal.
- **Hilltop**
 - Pushing back green waste that we have collected from Village Streets and Village properties.
- **Garage**
 - 1997 Ford Johnstown sweeper fixed. Rear motor fuel pump snapped bolts off mount and fixed wiring to fuel pump.
 - 1986 Army working on fuel pump.
 - Fixed and repaired chainsaws.
 - Getting ready for scrap steel run.
 - Washing and cleaning of equipment.
 - Disinfecting equipment and what was touched in the garage.
 - Employee Temperature Checks every day.
 - Cleaning garage.
 - Working on the Fire System in the Garage.
 - Getting ready for Hazardous waste run.
 - Garbage out Thursday's mornings.
