# Water/Sewer

- Mowing at Water Treatment Plant
- Sewer Complaint on S. Main- Sewer bagged and Mini Jetted line. Used our cutter. Finally, with the help of the camera company they jetted the main line while we pushed water out. The combination of jets flushed the problem. Found a manhole submerged out front of the house in the process which was unearthed and now accessible.
- Sewer Project Lamberson- A 2 home combined sewer. A company came in a dug from 10 Lamberson to the sidewalk. This is news because it is a 6-inch line and we need to investigate that for a manhole. Line was Jetted.
- Shut off service at 22 McKinnley per property owners request to change out internal valve.
   Upon valve repair service was repaired.
- Cut trees at Water Treatment Plant- around fence line and removed down trees threatening fence.
- Removed Debris from WWTP
- Water turned off on Horn St- Another valve replacement.
- Helped with Polymer at WWTP.
- Turned off water at 66 West State St-internal valve issue.
- Sewer complaint Faville Ave- Contractor dug and installed new pipe.

### **Streets**

- Green waste going well with trucks being dropped off to residents.
- Update: Stable for the time being (Investigate sink hole on Baker St- Cut and explored hole, filled in).
- Met with Parkside "Cut off pole in ground"-They had questions about signage due to hitting with mower. Will be put on list for removal.
- Paving- Completed for the season.
- Cold Patching throughout Village.
- Cutting overhanging trees on roadway (Trees that may Damage the plow trucks)
- End of Vanburen St Hill is in poor condition.
  We filled in low areas, filled in around the manhole we found and tried to generally save the pavement.
- Sink hole complaint over by Lutheran Church and hole was filled.
- Called on Christmas light Display- have been ordered and are in route.
- Sealed roads and put out flyers notifying residents beforehand.
- Prepped signage for Manhole Project
- Beaver Dam- Materials were removed and rearranged to create access to lower dam.
   Dam has been 55% removed, access has now been created, ground leveled all the way around the mouth of the drain pipe for

machinery access if necessary. Access has been made to the upper Dam and pond is currently been drained to Pre Beaver levels. Property owners are setting different traps, hoping for a resolution soon.

- Shimming Millers Grove Road
- Checked on Collapsing storm drain -Beaver/Cline-Repaired.
- Investigated storm sewer "Leak" Cline St Hill-Found broken collar. We will call in a dig for repair.

   Replaced brakes on driver's side front wheel, had several codes due to emission issues. It is currently back. Rear emergency lights were repaired inhouse
