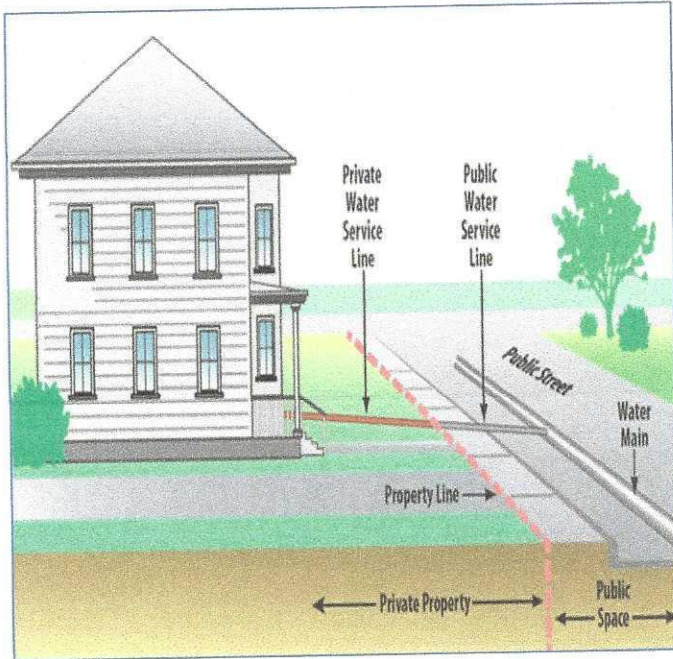


VILLAGE OF DOLGEVILLE



Last year, the Village of Dolgeville Water Department began work to identify and document any lead water service lines in the community. You may recall receiving a survey postcard asking for you to report what type of water service piping you have in your home. The next step is for the Village to verify the materials in your home and also the service line pipe material in the yard.

To see the pipe material of the Village-owned side of the service line, you may see DPW dig a small test hole in the front of your home, near the side walk and/or in the street.

To verify the material on the privately-owned side, each residence will need to be inspected. These are brief, visual inspections that should not take more than 10 minutes of your time.

The Village of Dolgeville Water Inspector, will identify himself to you and show identification. The inspector will ask a few questions, ask to enter your home and take a photo of the pipe where it enters your home, which is typically located in the basement. All homes/businesses served by Village of Dolgeville Water will need to be inspected.
